


Your participating Dealer will guide you through our three available Vehicle Service Protection plans to help you determine which level best suits your needs:

Powertrain coverage includes your vehicle's engine, transmission, transaxle or transfer case, drive axles, and certain hybrid and electric components.

Gold coverage encompasses Powertrain coverage, plus front and rear suspension, climate control, fuel, electrical, and certain additional hybrid and electric components.

Platinum coverage includes all mechanical parts of your vehicle in the event of a mechanical breakdown, unless they are specifically listed as "not covered" in your Customer Agreement (such as maintenance and cosmetic items).





# May waive charges associated with:

# Coverage exclusions may apply:4

- Any itemized excess wear and use charge that exceeds \$1,000
- Repairs performed prior to lease agreement termination
- Charges for alterations or modifications to the vehicle
- Vehicles used for competitive driving, racing or a prohibited commercial purpose
- Charges caused by the customer's wrongful or reckless acts








- Transferable to another private party for a fee, if your finance agreement is assumed<sup>4</sup>
- Cancelable at any time, subject to a fee after 30 days<sup>4</sup>

GAP Plus coverage offers a \$1,000 credit available at the original selling Dealer toward the purchase of a replacement vehicle.<sup>2</sup>

- Vehicles used for competitive racing or for a prohibited commercial purpose, including, but not limited to, ride share services
- If the customer has refinanced the vehicle finance agreement
- Deductions taken by the primary insurer, such as prior damage, salvage, missing items, excess towing, custom equipment, and storage


